



TEAM PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES

YOU ARE THE MAIN COMMUNICATION LIASON BETWEEN THE LEAGUE, YOUR MANAGER & COACHES, AND THE TEAM'S PARENTS. CONSIDER YOURSELF THE "MANAGER OF THE PARENTS"

Distribute and Collect Uniforms

Jersey Forms can be found on our website under Resources. Please ensure that you fill it out with each players jersey number. Once all jerseys have been assigned to players, please add their jersey numbers to the roster in TeamSnap. Be sure to keep a copy for your records to ensure that all jerseys are washed and handed back in at the end of the season.

Assign Team Duties

The following duties will be required for the season:

- Scorekeeping
- Pitch Count
- Field Prep

T-Ball and Coach Pitch will not require scorekeepers or pitch counters however the following roles are required:

- Bench parent(s)- one to two bench parents are needed at each game. The role of the bench coach is to ensure Player safety (everyone must have a helmet on and strapped up while on the bench and they are not up swinging bats around) and Correct batting order during games.
- Snack Parent –If your team decides to do snack one parent is needed to be in charge of coordinating the snack schedule to ensure that the children have a snack at the end of every game to keep it consistent.

Asking parents for assistance is always a great idea however making a schedule can also work best. Don't be afraid to let parents know that you will be setting up a rotating schedule to include the above duties. Coaches and Managers main priority is to stay focused on the kids.
